**Speakers:** *Kevin Marshia, VTrans* – Kevin will discuss the Vermont Highway Safety Alliance, what it is, who is involved, and what types of efforts they get involved with. One of the initiatives that has come from their efforts was some recent safety improvements on US 4 from Woodstock to Hartford.

*Evan Detrick, DuBois & King* – Evan will discuss the design of the Quechee Covered Bridge. This bridge was heavily damaged by Tropical Storm Irene and the Quechee community decided to replace the entire structure. The replacement structure is a combination of timber framing and precast concrete materials. The bridge is on a National Highway System route and the project was partially funded by FHWA rather than FEMA.
